What To Expect

Initial Contact with DOH-Lee

- Stop at front desk to check in
- Sit in lobby. A clerk will call you back to assist you.
- Once called by clerk, present all eligibility documents.
- Clerk will register you as a client in the RHP and follow up with a phone call when appointment is available.

Initial Health Assessment

- Stop at front desk to check in
- Sit in lobby. A clerk will call you back to assist you.
- Clerk will call you back to review information/documents, provide health system documents, and set appt for Second Health Assessment
- Nurse will assess your vital signs (height, weight, blood pressure, oxygen saturation, respirations, and temperature)
- Nurse will review and document your medical history
- Nurse will ask about any medications you're taking, allergies, and other significant medical information
- Nurse will provide vaccinations
- Nurse will provide a slip to have lab work completed (urine, blood, and stool)
- Nurse will address any questions or concerns

Second Health Assessment

- Stop at front desk to check in
- Sit in lobby. A clerk will call you back to assist you.
- Clerk will call you back to review information/documents and may set appt for additional vaccines in IMM clinic
- Nurse will assess your vital signs (height, weight, blood pressure, oxygen saturation, respirations, and temperature)
- Nurse will review and document your medical history
- Nurse will review your medications
- Nurse will perform a head-to-toe physical assessment
- Nurse will provide vaccinations
- Nurse will provide a referral letter to PCP
- Nurse will address any questions or concerns

Note: Each assessment may take at least an hour. Please arrange your schedule and transportation accordingly.
